No travel during inclement weather, vehicles which are underway must exit at first available safe haven and park until weather clears.
Watch overhead clearances.

Chester time restrictions: No movement on weekdays between 6:30 AM-8:30 AM and 2:15 PM-4:30 PM No movement on Fridays November 1st thru April 15th after 2:15 PM
