

Notification of Violation by Commercial Driver

Print and mail this completed application to Driver and Vehicle Services, 445 Minnesota Street, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-5180.

- Under Minnesota Statute 171.168, the holder of a Minnesota Commercial Driver's License (CDL) shall notify the Department of Public Safety within 30 days upon conviction of:
 - Any criminal offense
 - A serious traffic violation as defined in Code of Federal Regulations, title 49, section 383.5
 - Violating any other state or local law relating to a motor vehicle traffic control (other than a parking violation) in any type of motor vehicle in another state or jurisdiction.
